On October 9, I wrote to you to inquire whether or not you had received any documents from either LNDD or UCI in response to your August 7, 2006 request for laboratory documentation related to any prior and subsequent test results, for use in any longitudinal analysis. In your October 13 response, you indicated that you had received some documentation, and that you intend to bates stamp the documentation after "all of it" had been received. You also indicated that you would provide the documentation after it had been bates stamped, and "at the latest at the time [USADA's] exhibits are due prior to the arbitration."

While I do agree that bates stamping will be useful for the purpose of the arbitration, and appreciate your efforts in that regard, I would prefer to receive the longitudinal documents as they are received, as any further withholding of these documents by USADA prejudices Landis in his ability to prepare his defense.
